

Healing Scriptures

1. “For I am the LORD **who heals you**.” Exodus 15:26 (NKJV)

Note: In this verse, the Lord reveals Himself as Jehovah Rapha, which means “the Lord who heals you.” Jehovah (YHWH) = the covenant name of God. Rapha = to heal, restore, make whole, mend, cure. God isn’t just saying “I heal,” He’s revealing: healing is who I am.

1. “But he [Jesus] was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on him, and **by his wounds we are healed**.” Isaiah 53:5 (NIV)
2. “Lord my God, I called to you for help, and you **healed me**.” Psalm 30:2 (NIV)
3. “He [Jesus] himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. **By his wounds, you have been healed**.” 1 Peter 2:24 (ESV)
4. “Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. And **the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well**; the Lord will raise them up. **If they have sinned, they will be forgiven**. Therefore **confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed**. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.” James 5:14-16 (NIV)
5. “Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits—³ who **forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases**, ⁴ who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion.” Psalm 103:2-4 (NIV)
6. “‘I **will restore you to health and heal your wounds**,’ declares the Lord.” Jeremiah 30:17 (NIV)
7. “Pay attention to what I say; **turn your ear to my words**. ²¹ Do not let them out of your sight, keep them within your heart; ²² for they are **life** to those who find them and **health to one’s whole body**.” Proverbs 4:20-22 (NIV)
8. “**You restored me to health and let me live**. Surely it was for my benefit that I suffered such anguish. In your love you kept me from the pit of destruction; you have put all my sins behind your back.” Isaiah 38:16b-17 (NIV)
9. “The Lord will keep you **free from every** disease.” Deuteronomy 7:15a (NIV)
10. “The Lord **sustains** them on their sickbed and **restores** them from their bed of illness.” Psalm 41:3 (NIV)
12. “**He gives power to the weak**, and to those who have no might **He increases strength** ...Those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.” Isaiah 40:29,31 (NKJV)
13. “If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you... he... will also give **life to your mortal bodies**...” Romans 8:11 (ESV)

14. "This is my comfort in my affliction, that **your promise gives me life**." Psalm 119:50 (ESV)
15. "He **heals the brokenhearted** and **binds up their wounds**." Psalm 147:3 (ESV)
16. "Beloved, I pray that **all may go well with you** and that **you may be in good health**, as it goes **well with your soul**." 3 John 1:2 (ESV)
17. "Affliction will **not** rise up a second time." Nahum 1:9 (NKJV)
18. "Lord, be gracious to us; we long for you. Be our **strength** every morning, our **salvation** in time of distress." Isaiah 33:2 (NIV)
19. "Jesus looked at them and said, "With man this is impossible, but **with God all things are possible**." Matthew 19:26
"For **with God nothing will be impossible**." Luke 1:37 (NKJV)
"But Jesus looked at them and said, 'With men it is impossible, but not with God; for **with God all things are possible**.'" Mark 10:27 (NKJV)
20. "But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness shall rise with **healing** in its wings. You shall go out leaping like calves from the stall." Malachi 4:2 (ESV)
21. "Then He who sat on the throne said, 'Behold, I make all things new.'" Revelation 21:5b (NKJV)
22. "Thus says the Lord to His anointed ... I will go before you and **make the crooked places straight**." Isaiah 45:1a-2a (NKJV)
"This is what the Lord says to his anointed, ... to **open doors** before him so that gates will not be shut:
² I will go before you and will **level the mountains**; I will break down gates of bronze and cut through bars of iron. ³ I will give you **hidden treasures**, riches stored in secret places, so that you may know that I am the Lord, the God of Israel, who summons you by name. Isaiah 45:1a-3
23. "The Lord is my shepherd, **I lack nothing**. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, **he refreshes my soul**. He guides me along the right paths for his name's sake. Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will **fear no evil**, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they **comfort me**." Psalm 23:1-4 (NIV)
24. "**Trust in the Lord** with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the Lord and shun evil. This will bring **health to your body** and **nourishment to your bones**." Proverbs 3:5-8 (NIV)
25. "**Do not be anxious about anything**, but in everything by **prayer** and **supplication** with **thanksgiving** let your requests be made known to God. And the **peace of God**, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:6-7 (ESV)
26. "Not only that, but we **rejoice** in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces **endurance**, and endurance produces **character**, and character produces **hope**." Romans 5:3-4 (ESV)

27. "Heal me, O Lord, and **I shall be healed**; save me, and I shall be saved, for you are my praise."
Jeremiah 17:14 (ESV)
28. "Have mercy on me, Lord, for I am faint; **heal me, Lord**, for my bones are in agony." Psalm 6:2 (NIV)
29. "**Worship** the Lord your God, and his **blessing** will be on your food and water. **I will take away sickness from among you...**" Exodus 23:25 (NIV)
30. "The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; **he delivers them from all their troubles**. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit." Psalm 34:17-18 (NIV)
31. "As for me, I said, 'O Lord, be gracious to me; **heal me**, for I have sinned against you!'" Psalm 41:4 (ESV)
32. "And my **God will meet all your needs** according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:19 (NIV)
33. "But he said to me, 'My **grace** is sufficient for you, for my **power is made perfect in weakness**.' Therefore I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that **Christ's power may rest on me**.'" 2 Corinthians 12:9 (NIV)
34. "Come and let us return [in repentance] to the LORD, ... He will heal us; ... He will bandage us. Hosea 6:1 (AMP)
35. "**Gracious words** are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and **healing to the bones**." Proverbs 16:24 (NIV)
36. "Is not this the kind of **fasting** I have chosen: to **loose the chains of injustice** and **untie the cords of the yoke**, to **set the oppressed free** and **break every yoke**? ⁷ Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter—when you see the naked, to clothe them, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? ⁸ Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and **your healing will quickly appear**; then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the Lord will be your rear guard. ⁹ Then you will call, and the Lord will answer; you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I." Isaiah 58:6-9 (NIV)
37. "And Peter said to him, 'Aeneas [*your name*], **Jesus Christ heals you**; rise and make your bed.' And immediately he rose." Acts 9:34 (ESV)
38. "A **happy heart** is **good medicine** and a **joyful mind** causes **healing**, But a broken spirit dries up the bones." Proverbs 17:22 (AMP)
39. "He [Jesus] said to her, 'Daughter, your **faith has healed you**. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering.'" Mark 5:34 (NIV)
40. "If you say, '**The Lord is my refuge**,' and you make the Most High your dwelling, **no harm** will overtake you, **no disaster** will come near your tent." Psalm 91:9–10 (NIV)

41. “Nevertheless, I **will** bring **health** and **healing** to it; I **will heal my people** and will let them enjoy abundant peace and security.” Jeremiah 33:6 (NIV)
42. “Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and he saved them from their distress. **He sent out his word and healed them**; he rescued them from the grave. Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for mankind.” Psalm 107:19-21 (NIV)
43. “Peace, peace, to those far and near,” says the Lord. “And I **will heal them**.” I have seen their ways, and I **will heal them**.” Isaiah 57:19b (NIV)
44. “While you stretch out your hand to heal, and signs and wonders are performed through the name of your holy servant Jesus.” Acts 4:30 (ESV)
45. “The Lord gives sight to the blind, **the Lord lifts up those who are bowed down**, the Lord loves the righteous.” Psalm 146:8 (NIV)
46. “This is what the Lord, the God of your father David, says: ‘I have heard your prayer and seen your tears; I **will heal you**.’” 2 Kings 20:5 (NIV)
47. “Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them **authority** to drive out impure spirits and to **heal every disease and sickness**.” Matthew 10:1 (NIV)
48. “Hear, Lord, and be **merciful** to me; Lord, be my **help**. You turned my wailing into **dancing**; you removed my sackcloth and clothed me with **joy**.” Psalms 30:10-11 (NIV)
49. “Then He is gracious to him, and says, ‘Deliver him from going down to the Pit; I have found a ransom’; **His flesh shall be young like a child’s, He shall return to the days of his youth**.” Job 33:24–25 (NKJV)
50. “And his name [Jesus] —by faith in his name—has made this man strong... **the faith that is through Jesus has given** the man this **perfect health**...” Acts 3:16 (ESV)

Jesus Healed Them ALL Scriptures

51. “And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and **healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people**. Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments... and **He healed them**.” Matthew 4:23-24 (NKJV)
52. “When evening had come, they brought to Him [Jesus] many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and **healed all who were sick**.” Matthew 8:16 (NKJV)
53. “Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and **healing every disease and sickness**.” Matthew 9:35 (ESV)
54. “But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and **He healed them all**.” Matthew 12:15 (NKJV)

55. "And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with **compassion** for them, and **healed their sick**." Matthew 14:14 (NKJV)
56. "...they brought to Him all who were sick... and **as many as touched it** [*the hem (tassel) of Jesus' garment*] **were made perfectly well**." Matthew 14:35–36 (NKJV)
Note: The hem in Hebrew = tzit-tzit. Malachi 4:2: "healing in His wings" ("wings" refers to the four tzit-tzit (tassels) Jesus wore on the corners of his rectangular outer garment (shawl/"tallit"). The tzit-tzit represents the commandments of God—reminders that we are in covenant with Him (Numbers 15:38–39)—and prophetically points to Jesus, in whom the fullness of God's Word and healing power dwells.
57. "Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and **He healed them**." Matthew 15:30–31 (NKJV)
58. "And great multitudes followed Him, and **He healed them** there." Matthew 19:2 (NKJV)
59. "Then the blind and the lame came to Him in the temple, and **He healed them**." Matthew 21:14 (NKJV)
60. "...they began to carry about on beds those who were sick... and **as many as touched Him were made well**." Mark 6:55–56 (NKJV)
61. "When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and **He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them**." Luke 4:40 (NKJV)
62. "However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be **healed by Him of their infirmities**." Luke 5:15 (NKJV)
63. "...a great multitude of people... came to hear Him and be healed of their diseases... and the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and **healed them all**." Luke 6:17–19 (NKJV)
64. "When the crowds learned it, they followed him [Jesus], and he welcomed them and spoke to them of the kingdom of God and **cured those who had need of healing**." Luke 9:11 (ESV)
65. "...God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and **healing all** who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him." Acts 10:38 (NKJV)
Note: In this scripture, "healing" comes from the Greek: iaomai, meaning: to heal, cure, restore to wholeness.

Jesus Instructs Believers to Heal in His Name

66. [Jesus said:] "**Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse** those who have leprosy, **drive out demons**. Freely you have received; freely give." Matthew 10:8 (NIV)
67. [Jesus said:] "And **these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues;** ¹⁸ they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they

drink deadly poison, it **will not hurt them** at all; **they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.**" Mark 16:17-18 (NIV)

68. [Jesus said:] "Listen carefully: **I have given you authority** [that you now possess] to tread on serpents and scorpions, and [the ability to exercise authority] **over all the power of the enemy** (Satan); and **nothing will [in any way] harm you.**" Luke 10:19 (AMP)

Healing Through Believers After Jesus' Resurrection

69. "By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. **It is Jesus' name and the faith that comes through him that has completely healed him**, as you can all see." Acts 3:16 (NIV)
70. "Now, Lord, ... enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness. ³⁰ Stretch out your hand to **heal** and perform signs and wonders through the name of your holy servant Jesus." Acts 4:29a-30 (NIV)
71. "...they brought the sick out into the streets... and **they were all healed.**" Acts 5:15–16 (NKJV)
72. "Peter said to him, '**Jesus the Christ heals you.** Arise and make your bed.' Then he arose immediately." Acts 9:33b–34 (NKJV)
73. "This man heard Paul speaking. Paul, observing him intently and **seeing that he had faith to be healed**, said with a loud voice, 'Stand up straight on your feet!' And he leaped and walked." Acts 14:9–10 (NKJV)
74. "God did extraordinary miracles through Paul [*your name*], ¹² so that even handkerchiefs and aprons that had touched him were taken to the sick, and their **illnesses were cured** and the evil spirits left them." Acts 19:11–12 (NIV)
75. "...Paul went in to him and **prayed... and healed him**. So when this was done, the rest... also came and were **healed.**" Acts 28:8–9 (NKJV)
76. "Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders... and **the prayer of faith will save the sick**, and the Lord will raise him up." James 5:14–15 (NKJV)
77. "For the man was over forty years old on whom this **miracle of healing** had been performed." Acts 4:22 (NKJV)
78. "And the multitudes with one accord heeded the things spoken by Philip... For unclean spirits... came out... and many who were paralyzed and lame were **healed.**" Acts 8:6–7 (NKJV)
79. "But Peter put them all out, and knelt down and prayed... 'Tabitha, **arise.**' And she opened her eyes... Then he gave her his hand and lifted her up..." Acts 9:40–41 (NKJV)

80. "But Paul... said to the spirit, 'I command you in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her.' And he came out that very hour." Acts 16:18 (NKJV)
81. "Seated in a window was a young man named Eutychus, who was sinking into a deep sleep as Paul talked on and on. When he was sound asleep, he fell to the ground from the third story and was picked up dead. ¹⁰ Paul went down, **threw himself on the young man and put his arms around him.** 'Don't be alarmed,' he said. 'He's alive!' ¹² The people took the young man home alive and were greatly comforted." Acts 20:9–10,12 (NIV)
82. "...to another **gifts of healings** by the same Spirit." 1 Corinthians 12:9 (NKJV)
83. "...God has appointed these in the church... **gifts of healings**..." 1 Corinthians 12:28 (NKJV)
84. "Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and **works miracles among you**..." Galatians 3:5 (NKJV)
85. "How shall we escape if we ignore so great a salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him. ⁴ God also testified to it by **signs, wonders** and various **miracles**, and by **gifts of the Holy Spirit** distributed according to his will." Hebrews 2:3–4 (NIV)
86. "In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, **rise up and walk**... immediately his feet and ankle bones received **strength**." Acts 3:6–8 (NKJV)
